

THE TRAINING

The 3 Month Program

- Two programs per year (Spring and Fall)
- Classes and Orientations are free
- Personal expenses and transportation must be paid by missionaries
- Approximate Costs for 3 Months (USD):
 - Food: \$250
 - Immigration: \$75
 - Personal: \$50
 - Transportation: \$50

Requirements

- Must be willing to serve a minimum of 6 months in the mission field when the program ends after 3 months
- Need a valid passport
- Must be 18 years or older
